Description of skills developed	 Learners engage in career awareness opportunities and gather a spectrum of career pathway information to include tasks, wages, skills, etc for career pathways within the state of New Hampshire Learners identify their personal interests and skills related to potential career pathways within in New Hampshire through career awareness activities Learners are able to connect their interests to potential career pathways and explain their desire to pursue further knowledge in a pathway 	 Learners recognize the skills, education, credentials, and work experience needed to succeed in their career pathway Learners rationalize why they want to be in a specific career pathway drawing on their interests and skills. Learners will develop professional communication skills and develop their social capital through engagement with community partners and industry 	Learners develop a portfolio of artifacts that have been completed within in their career pathway Learners reflect on industry immersed experiences in which they have applied academic, technical, and employability skills Learners demonstrate a proficient level of career readiness through engagement with employers
