Licensure Pathways

- Traditional pathways approved educator preparation programs
- Demonstrated Competency
 - Portfolio/Oral Board
 - National License (National Board, DOD, NASP)
 - Transcript Analysis
 - Out-of-State experience under a license earned by alternative pathway
- Site-Based Licensing Plan

Licensure Pathways – Hiring Tips

- Not all credentials are licenses.
 - EA, IPLA, SOE, etc.
 - Endorsement in NH vs some other states
- Not all licenses are the same
 - Comparability of endorsement
- Reciprocity is not guaranteed
 - Testing, degree, and/or experience requirements
- Trust, but verify

 - Individual school
 - Collaborative effort

EIS and SAU renumbering

- What was done
 - All Charter school agencies assigned their own "SAU" number
 - CS agencies with multiple schools have each under the single SAU number
- What this means for you
 - Check to verify that you have access from MyNHDOE single sign-on to your newly renumbered SAU and school(s)
 - Enter a new Hire Date for each credentialed employee
 - The DOE will enter an end date in the SAU 401 employment record for those employees
