FAQ for CTE After Dark RFA Addendum 1 Issued January 6, 2023

The following questions were submitted after the CTE After Dark Information Session on December 14, 2022 and are added as an official addendum to the RFA..

- Q: Without certification requirements for Adult Education teachers, what will qualify a teacher as such?
- A: Teacher qualifications in adult ed depend on the program type.
 - For an AEL program, there are no certification requirements. Please check with your local school district on whether an uncertified AEL instructor is allowed to teach a credit-bearing course. Additional requirements such as an application for alternative certification or performing under a certified lead teacher may be required.
 - For an ADP program, please see Ed 702.02 Certification of Teachers.
- Q: The RFA specifies that participants be on a path to high school completion. Does this mean ESL learners and career changers are not eligible?
- A: Participant must meet the eligibility requirements under WIOA for adult education or under Ed 700 for the Adult Diploma program. The primary focus of the program is to provide secondary level academic instruction in combination with an occupational credential that leads to transition into employment and/or postsecondary education/training. English language learners and career changers with low literacy levels may be appropriate. The applicant is responsible for the development of admissions criteria.
- Q: The First 2 priorities for eligible participants are students in Bureau funded Adult Ed programs. Can participants be recruited for the CTE After Dark Program and then enrolled in Adult Education? Or must the participant be enrolled in SE first?
- A: Participants must be eligible and appropriate for adult education services under either the AEL or the ADP eligibility requirements including those established at the local level.
