A free and secure <u>my Social Security</u> account provides personalized tools for everyone, whether you receive benefits or not. You can use your account to request a replacement Social Security card, check the status or an application, estimate future benefits, or manage the benefits you already receive. All from anywhere!

What can you do with a my Social Security account?

If you are receiving benefits:

- Request a replacement Social Security card
- Print a benefit verification letter
- Report your monthly wages
- Set up or change direct deposit
- Get a Social Security 1099 (SSA-1099) form
- Opt out of mailed notices for those available online
- Change your address
 - If you change your address with Social Security, please remember to contact NHVR to update your address

If you are not receiving benefits:

- · Request a replacement Social Security card
- Get personalized retirement benefit estimates
- Get estimates for spouse's benefits
- Get proof that you do not receive benefits
- Check your application status
- Get your Social Security Statement
