What is it?	An experience that provides real world and hands on application of skills connected to related instruction received in the classroom. Paid internships must be at minimum wage or higher and place interns on the payroll of the employer.	A registered apprenticeship program (RAP) is an industry driven experience in a specific occupation. For a RAP there are 5 components business involvement, structured on the job training, related instruction, graduated payscale in line with increasing skills, and a nationally recognized certification.	A youth apprenticeship program (YAP), has the same guidelines and components as a Registered apprenticeship program (RAP) but geared towards 16-14 year old individuals.	Pre-apprenticeships connect directly to registered apprenticeship programs (RAP) and allow for exploration before committing to a RAP. They feed in to the RAP and allow employers to interview/hire individuals that choose to apply as an apprentice.	A paid experience that allows students that are 16 and 17 and enrolled in a course of study and actively training in a cooperative career training program under a state recognized educational authority to work in hazardous occupations that have exemptions per federal child labor laws.	Employer directly hires a student for a part-time, summer, full-time paid position.
