Training Description:

FY '25 Special Education Cost Simulator Tool Training

This training provides guidance to the districts in using the special education cost simulator tool. RSA 186-D:3 mandates that the Department of Education (Department) provide all school districts with:

- materials to facilitate the information of a Special Education Cost Recovery Association,
- provide information on the Department's website of each special education cost recovery association,
- gather current student data regarding claims and costs which adhere to confidentiality.
- arrange one or more educational opportunities for interested school districts regarding risk management topics (risk pools, risk calculators, premium predictors, required information for actuarial calculations, the effects of claims on future premiums and the advantages and disadvantages of using insurance products to achieve the goals of the association); and
- annually assist the special education cost recovery governing board by calculating the unreimbursed special education amounts to be paid to the risk pool member districts from the risk pool funds.
