

We Are VR: Working with Community Rehabilitation Providers

VR New Hampshire transforms the lives of individuals with disabilities by helping them prepare for, obtain, and succeed in meaningful careers.

When we begin working with a new participant, the first step is to listen to you and make a plan for achieving your employment goals. Depending on the circumstances, there may be times when we partner with a Community Rehabilitation Provider (CRP) to help us serve you better.

What is a CRP?

CRPs are approved partner organizations funded by VR New Hampshire to work with VR participants. They support our array of services by helping VR participants explore and/or obtain employment that matches their interests and goals.

How can a CRP help me?

In partnership with your VR Counselor, CRPs help you explore and secure rewarding career opportunities by:

- Researching the labor market to find promising jobs that match your interests
- Helping you prepare for interviews and draft resumes, cover letters, job applications, and thank you letters
- Arranging for informational interviews and job shadow opportunities

Will CRPs support me after I get a job?

Yes! Once you're on the job, CRP staff can continue to support you and your new employer by:

- Identifying what supports are needed to ensure success, including accommodations
- Assisting with job training, job coaching, and employment-related supports
