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New Hampshire Accounting and Health Science Rigorous Plans of Study

INTRODUCTION:

The Accounting and Health Science Rigorous Plans of Study is a collaborative effort among New Hampshire secondary, postsecondary and industry partners to create seamless pathways that include dual enrollment opportunities for students from NH Accounting and Health Science Technologies Career and Technical Secondary Education to the Community College System of New Hampshire, Rivier College and Southern New Hampshire University.

Consistent with the Carl Perkins Act of 2006 [Sec. 122(c)(1)(A)], Dual Credit Articulated Programs of Study

1. *Incorporate secondary education and postsecondary education elements;*
2. *Includes coherent and rigorous content aligned with challenging academic standards and relevant career and technical content in a coordinated, non-duplicative progression of courses that align secondary education to adequately prepare students to succeed in postsecondary education;*
3. *...include the opportunity for secondary education students to participate in dual or concurrent enrollment programs or other ways to acquire postsecondary education credits; and*
4. *Lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree.*

This Dual Credit Articulated Program of Study outlines the arrangement between the secondary and postsecondary educational systems to grant college credit to students enrolled in an Accounting and Health Science & Technologies CTE programs that have been approved for one or more New Hampshire Community College, Rivier College or Southern NH University courses through their dual enrollment programs according to their terms and conditions. These courses include: Accounting 1, Accounting & Financial Reporting1, Financial Accounting, Introduction to Exercise Science, Medical Law and Ethics, and Medical Terminology.
