Annual Report

An Institutional Annual Report will be submitted each year for each Institution of Higher Education (IHE) approved by the Council for Teacher Education (CTE). The report is due to the New Hampshire Department of Education (NHDOE) by August 1st.

- Note any substantive changes you envision making and their anticipated impact on your current systems.
- Note any additions of new programs.
- Describe developments taken to address recent State Board of Education directives (e.g. information about candidate selectivity, how the institution plans on determining students have required content knowledge).
- Describe noteworthy innovations or accomplishments in educator preparation (e.g. initiatives and collaboration with P12 schools, state educational reform efforts, grants, addressing the critical shortages, STEM).

3. Progress report, if necessary, based on the most recent program approval review:

- Organize in terms of:
 - a. Program-specific standards.
 - b. Unit-level standards.
- Briefly summarize steps taken to address each area of need.
- Provide sources of evidence.
