RE: FY12 Adequate Education Aid Grants and Statewide Property Tax Figures

Using the current school funding law, the Department of Education has calculated the estimated Adequate Education Aid grants and property tax figures.

Pursuant to RSA 198:40-a,V, attached please find a spreadsheet that provides the estimated amounts of FY2012 Adequacy grants. A description of the methodology is included. These amounts are estimates only based on the current Adequacy formula. The formula is subject to review and change by the Legislature in the upcoming legislative session. As such, the estimated adequacy grants reflected in this notice may change prior to the next fiscal year. For purposes of local budgeting, no municipality should expect to receive substantially more or less in adequacy education grants than it received in FY2011.
