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Compliance Tip of the Month: 2 CFR 200

What is 2 CFR? Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations (2 CFR), is the primary regulation governing grants and cooperative agreements issues by the US Government.

What is 2 CFRs Purpose? Its purpose is to streamline guidance, reduce administrative burden on award recipients, and guard against waste, fraud, and abuse of Federal funds?

Note: 2 CFR will be updating this year with a possible timeframe of October 2024. Trainings will be scheduled once the update has been approved.
